
## ART ROOM PROCEDURES

**Expectations** 




1. Respect and follow all art room routines and procedures.

5. Maintain a clean and orderly work area.
6. Bring all of your supplies to class daily.
7. Complete all of your work and turn it in on time with your name and rubric attached.

1. **First warning:** The teacher provides a verbal reminder to student.

## DUE DATES



\* I recognize that everyone works at a different pace and will do my best to be sensitive to the individual needs of each student when setting project due dates. However, my expectation is that each student uses class time **wisely** in order to complete their work by the due date that I have set.

\* If a student has concerns about the due date on any given project, it is that student's responsibility to approach me with their concerns so that we might work towards a solution together.

## ABSENTEE POLICY



\* It is the student's responsibility to check with me and/or a fellow classmate about what they missed while they were absent.

\* A student has two extra days to turn in any work assigned on a day a student was absent. If a quiz was administered on a day a student was absent, the quiz must be made up on the first day the student returns. If previously assigned work was due on the day of the absence, the work is due on the first day the student returns.

## TECHNOLOGY



It is expected that students use the technology provided to them respectfully and wisely while in the art room. Students are to stay on task when using school computers and to follow the technology procedures posted around the classroom (as well as all school/handbook rules in reference to technology) at all times.

## PLAGIARISM



**Plagiarism is the taking of ideas, writings, and artwork of another and passing them off as one's own.**

**In this class, plagiarism includes...**

1. turning in another's **work** as one's own
2. **copying** work from a friend before class (or while in another class)
3. including a source but failing to **cite** it
4. copying an **artist's work** and passing it off as one's own

**Students caught plagiarizing will be given a ZERO for the assignment.**
